Analysis was carried out during Dress ID project. Date was rejected as too young, because of context. This textile has been dated three times: KIA-38158 (too young), KIA-39826, KIA-39838. The differences are too important to be caused solemnly by inherent statistical uncertainty. The best estimate for the real age of this textile is the average of KIA-39826 and KIA-39838: 1760+/-60BP (cf.
